The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 14.01.2018, registered under Sections 307,452,336,323,427,506,148,149 of IPC and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar.

Heard.

No injury is attributed to the petitioner. Further, no recovery is stated to have been effected from them.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners Sukhbir Singh @ Sona and Bikramjit Singh @ Vicky are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate,

Amritsar subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) The petitioners shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
