Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.269, dated 29.09.2017, registered under Sections 354-A, 355, 506, 294 IPC read with Section 12 of POCSO Act (added subsequently).

Counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 31.05.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation.

State counsel states that the petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation.

So far as petitioner No.2 is concerned, his petition was dismissed on the last date of hearing.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.05.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner No.1-Rekha Rani, is made absolute

subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)  
(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
