The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.13 dated 09.02.2016 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Dasuya.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 22.01.2018, the petitioner has already surrendered before learned trial Court and deposited the costs of Rs.10,000/- with Sub Division Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel as well as by learned counsel for the complainant.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.01.2018 is made absolute.

However, it is directed that petitioner shall not repeat the same lapse(s) in future.

Petition stands disposed of.
