This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for quashing of the FIR No. 208 dated 31.12.2016, registered under Sections 323/324/325/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Report has been received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, District Amritsar that parties have effected compromise. Statements of both the parties have been recorded to the effect that the compromise effected between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

Since the dispute has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No. 208 dated 31.12.2016, registered under Sections 323/324/325/148/149 of

the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioners.
