Present petition has been filed for cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted by this Court vide Order dated 31.08.2012.

The basis of filing this application is that while arguing for granting concession of anticipatory bail, the respondent No.2/accused had made a misleading statement that her husband has been granted anticipatory bail; whereas in this case her husband was never granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that after obtaining the concession of anticipatory bail, respondent No.2 had duly appeared before the Trial Court pursuant to the start of proceedings against her. She was also released on bail pending trial by the Trial Court. Thereafter, respondent No. 2 has never evaded appearance before the Trial Court.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere and to cancel the anticipatory bail granted to the respondent No. 2 about six years back. Therefore, present petition is dismissed.
