ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.68 dated 02.03.2018 under Section 307/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR, which has been lodged by son-in-law of the petitioner, are that she along with other relatives had attacked the complainant with knives. He further contends that the allegations are general in nature and the petitioner has not been attributed any specific injury. The petitioner is in custody for almost three months ever since her arrest on 02.03.2018. It is further contended that the petitioner has fully recovered from the injuries.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for U.T. Chandigarh states that investigation in the case has been completed and challan has been presented before the competent Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is a lady and is in custody for almost three months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner-Rameshwari is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
