Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents not to harass the petitioner by summoning him in the investigation of FIR No.33 dated 19.02.2018 under Sections 279, 337, 338 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Traffic), Patiala filed in the Court today, is taken on record and as per this reply, during investigation of the aforesaid FIR, it is found that the same was wrongly registered against one Balkar Singh and the petitioner, by getting his vehicle repaired at Kaithal, has tried to destroy the evidence of the accident in order to save his driver and vehicle and therefore, the police has invoked Sections 201 IPC against the petitioner along with Sonu Singh, being accused in the FIR.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file anticipatory bail application.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
