Petitioner-Kavita Khatri has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.288 dated 10.04.2018, registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat, under Sections 323, 307, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned

State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner is named in the FIR. She is stated to be armed with *danda* and has given simple injury with *danda* on the head of the complainant. The injury dangerous to life has not been attributed to the present petitioner.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 23.05.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 23.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
