The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.282 dated 20.06.2017, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 427, 448, 452, 455, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 354, 395, 397 IPC deleted) at Police Station Pataudi, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 23.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
