Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.126 dated 30.03.2018 under Section 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

2.) This Court vide order dated 16.07.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Arresting

Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Arshpreet Kaur, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 16.07.2018, petitioner appeared before the Arresting Officer and joined the investigation. It is further submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 16.07.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
