FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner-Vicky in this second regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 27.06.2017 from his conscious possession 14 injection of *Buprenorphine*, each of 2 ml, commercial quantity were recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is behind the bars since 08 months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

The same is sought to be opposed by learned State counsel on the grounds that the quantity recovered is commercial and earlier bail application of the petitioner was declined by this Court vide orders dated 01.11.2017.

Keeping in view that the commercial quantity of the contraband has been recovered and that no fresh ground to allow such a relief to the petitioner is made out, the present application stands dismissed.
