Prayer in both the abovesaid petitions is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.93 dated 08.09.2016 under Sections 458, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of

the order dated 06.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-21168-2017 and order dated 08.08.2017 passed in CRM-M-23545-2017, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.
