Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for seeking bail pending trial in the FIR No. 762 dated 29.06.2017 under Sections 379-B, 307 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 417, 452, 468 and 471 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in the case at all. His name is not mentioned in the FIR. Despite being requested, nothing has been recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 27.07.2017. He is not required for any investigation purpose.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Jawahar Lal, does not dispute the fact regarding custody of the petitioner as well as the factum that nothing has been recovered from him. Learned State counsel further submits that charge in the case is yet to be framed.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing bond/sureties to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
