This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside order dated 21.09.2017 passed by the JMIC, Ludhiana (Annexure-1) wherein interim maintenance has been granted and wherein the JMIC Ludhiana has directed that a sum of ₹ 3,000/- be paid per month from the date of application to the applicant No.1 and ₹ 2,000/- per month for the applicant No.2-the minor child.

This order was challenged in a revision petition before the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana which has dismissed the same.

Aggrieved with the order passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, the instant petition has been filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the amount of maintenance that has been assessed is on the lower side. The minor child is school going and maintenance ought to be enhanced.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and I am not inclined to entertain the instant petition. At the moment, only interim maintenance had been allowed to the petitioners herein by taking into account the income of the respondent, as assessed to be around ₹13-14,000/- per month. This has been based upon the income-tax returns filed by the respondent.

I do not find any infirmity in the said order.
