The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.217 dated 17.12.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

The allegation against the petitioners is that they forged the affidavit which was submitted to the electricity department for issuance of electricity connection to the cold storage.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 19.1.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
