Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0067 dated 07.04.2018 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149, 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 24.05.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner, who is a lady, are that the petitioner had raised 'lalkara' and caused an injury on the head of the complainant with a sharp edged weapon. However, in the MLR, no injury was found on the head of the complainant and it is merely pain in the head. The petitioner herself had also received injuries in the incident. A copy of the MLR of the petitioner is placed on record as Annexure P-2.

Issue notice of motion to the respondent returnable on 18.07.2018.”

Thereafter, one another opportunity was granted to the petitioner to join the investigation vide order dated 18.07.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid orders, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
