Prayer in this petition is for transfer the investigation in case FIR No.43 dated 22.05.2017, under Section 22 of the NDPS, Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Moga to some other independent agency.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.9-CBI has already been filed in which it has been stated that CBI has limited manpower and resources and is already over burdened and the investigation in this case can be done by the Senior Punjab State Police Officers.

Reply by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per this affidavit, after investigation was completed in this case, the same was got re-verified by DSP, City, Moga and, thereafter, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed on 08.08.2017 and the trial Court has framed charges on 18.08.2017.
