Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.28 dated 09.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 195-A/506/341 IPC, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, on the basis of compromise dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) .

Pursuant to order dated 24.05.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 01.06.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Samana, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.54, dated 05.06.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide Endst. No.2940/AL, dated 07.06.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Samana, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Samana, dated 05.06.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.28 dated 09.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 195-A/506/341 IPC, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
