The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.52 dated 4.6.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 324, 323, 34 Indian Penal Code (326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Raghubir Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and recovery has already been effected and nothing more is to be recovered from them.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 19.1.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
