Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition qua the challenge to the complaint with liberty to take all pleas, which have been taken with reference thereto, before the trial Court as and when required and further as regards the order dated 26.10.2017 (Annexure P-3), he states that the petitioner was never served in the case. Had it been known to the petitioner that there was such a complaint preferred against him, he would have invariably appeared before the Court below. He further states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the trial Court and would surrender himself before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on 31.05.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail, which may be considered and decided at an early date.

In view of the above, the present petition qua the challenge of the petitioner to the complaint No.852 of 2015 is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to take all pleas as taken herein before the trial Court as and when required.

Qua order dated 26.10.2017, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on **31.05.2018** and moves an

application for grant of regular bail, the said application shall be entertained and he be admitted to interim bail till a final decision is taken on the said application.
