In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail in case FIR No.184 dated 19.12.2016, under Sections 302/34/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kalka District Panchkula.

2.) Pursuant to the order dated 10.07.2018, one Sh. Om Parkash, HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalka, Panchkula has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 06.07.2018 along with Annexure R-1 relating to record of call detail, on behalf of the State of Haryana. The same is taken on record.

3.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that out of 31 witnesses, 19 witnesses have been examined. Complainant remained hostile.

4.) Heard.

5.) In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sapna Kalyan is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

6.) However, petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and she shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

7.) Petitioner shall also appear before the Station House Officer concerned on last Saturday of every month at 10.00 a.m. and mark her presence.
