Petitioner Rajeshwar Sharma @ Meet has approached this Court by way of filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to him in case FIR No.3 dated 06.01.2017 under Sections 307, 34 IPC (later on challan was presented under Sections 302, 307, 34 IPC) registered at Police Station – Sector 19, U.T., Chandigarh, during pendency of the trial.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, when this Court is not inclined to release the petitioner on bail, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition at this stage. However, he submits that direction be issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

The trial Court is directed to make all efforts to expedite the trial preferably within a period of six months.
