Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.30 dated 22.02.2018, under Sections 307, 336, 506, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Chhehrata, District Amritsar.

The bail is solely on the ground that bullet injury received by the injured was not at the hands of petitioner but at the hands of co-accused. However, it is mentioned in the FIR that petitioner along with associates armed with deadly weapons have attacked the victim Jugraj Singh @ Joga who received gun shot injury on the left side of the abdomen.

No case is made out to grant concession of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
