The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representation dated 18.05.2018 to be decided expeditiously.

At the very outset, learned counsel of the petitioner points out that there is a typographical error in the memo of parties i.e. while typing State of Punjab it was inadvertently typed as Haryana which is a bona-fide error and seeks permission to correct the same in the Court.

Ordered accordingly.

Let the necessary corrections be carried out in Court under his signatures.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondents No. 5 to 8, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided

expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mrs. Anju Arora, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 18.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
