The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to register a case against the private respondents on the basis of complaint dated 21.03.2018.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondents No.5 to 7, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the complaint should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks, on receipt

of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the complaint dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
