The petitioners are seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from respondents No.3 to 7.

It is stated in the petition that petitioners have performed their marriage, which is against the will of private respondents and they have apprehension that the private respondents might cause physical harm to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners shall be making a representation to respondent No.1 - Senior Superintendent of Police, UT Chandigarh today itself with regard to their grievance who may be directed to look into the same in accordance with law.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1 - Senior Superintendent of Police, UT Chandigarh that in the event of the petitioners making a representation he shall look into the same and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law to ensure that no

harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion with regard to the validity of the marriage has been expressed in this order.
