This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer for issuance of direction to arrest accused No. 4 to 7 in FIR No. 44 dated 24.4.2016 registered under Sections 363, 366 and 376-D IPC at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Status report has been filed in Court today. As per the report, after investigation, police officials raided the house of the accused with arrest warrants. The accused filed Criminal Misc. No. 28321 of 2016 in this Court and their arrest was stayed by order dated 23.9.2016. On 4.10.2017, Shaukat Ali, Imam Hussain and Fagra—respondents no. 4 to 6 respectively, were produced in the police station and they joined investigation and furnished their bail bonds. Another accused Attardin—respondent No. 7 has also joined investigation. In the status report submitted, it is mentioned that challan under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed

before the Illaqa Magistrate, Jalandhar on 20.12.2017.

In view of the fact that the accused in the aforementioned FIR, namely, respondents No. 4 to 7 were allowed concession of anticipatory bail by this Court and they have already joined investigation, no further orders are called for.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly, leaving it open to the petitioner to revive this petition, if need so arises.
