KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in DDR No. 23 dated 18.6.2011 registered under Sections 324, 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code registered in case FIR No. 18 dated 18.6.2011 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor District Moga.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner absented from the proceedings of the Court on 18.7.2017 and he was declared proclaimed offender on 12.9.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was arrested on 28.4.2018 and since then he is in custody. It is further contended that co-accused have already been released on probation and the petitioner is also ready to face the trial.

Considering the nature of offences and the fact that co-accused have already been released on probation by the trial Court, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs 25,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
