**RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.(ORAL)**

This is a petition filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 29.06.2016 registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa, under Sections 22 and 25 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Recovery effected from the petitioner is found to be commercial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in *State of Rajasthan Vs. Parmanand and another; 2014 AIR (SC) 1384*. However, in view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in case *Satpal Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2018 AIR (SC) 2011*, petitioner is not entitled to bail.

Petition is dismissed.

However, trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same as early as possible preferably, within a period of 04 months.
