This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail to petitioner-Virender Pal in case FIR No.38 dated 08.02.2018 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, he was not involved. Neither any recovery was effected from him nor anything else was recovered. There is non-compliance of mandatory provisions of NDPS Act. The petitioner is behind bars since 08.02.2018.

Learned counsel for the respondent-U.T. Chandigarh has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that all PWs have been examined and the date before the trial Court is fixed for today only i.e 06.12.2018 for recording the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

Keeping in view the stage of trial, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
