

Parveen @ Kacchi vs. State of Haryana

This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner Parveen @ Kacchi in case FIR No.187 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 302,307, 202 IPC read with Sections 25/27/29/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Moohana, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are total 34 witnesses, out of which 25 witnesses have been examined. The material witnesses have been examined and they have not supported the case of the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2016. Co-accused, namely, Pankaj @ Pinku has filed CRM-M-46276 of 2017 before this Court and vide order dated 18.05.2018, he has been released on regular bail.

Similarly, co-accused Dharmender has also been granted regular bail in CRM-M-33581 of 2017 and the trial may take some time to conclude.

Learned State counsel has also not disputed the custody period as well as examination of 25 witnesses and also grant of bail to both co-accused.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the contents of FIR and the documents on the file.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for

examined and co-accused, namely, Pankaj @ Pinku and Dharmender have been released on regular bail, this petition is allowed. The petitioner is behind the bars since 28.08.2016, no purpose would be served by keeping him in custody. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
