Prayer made in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.15 dated 09.03.2018 for offence under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The alleged is recovery of 300 grams of heroin, which is a commercial quantity. The argument that the police inspector Harish has taken the petitioner alongwith the vehicle, is a question of fact to be decided during trial.
