Prayer made herein is for transferring of a criminal case arising out of FIR No.243 dated 15.10.2016, under Sections 341, 323 and 506 IPC, Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh from the Courts at Chandigarh to any other District outside Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that both the parties are practicing in Chandigarh Courts and that in fact complainant Mr. N.K.Kapil, at some points of time had remained Secretary of District Bar Association, Chandigarh.

Notice of this petition was issued to the respondents.

Both the learned counsel for the parties are agreeable for transfer of the matter to the Courts at Mohali.

In view of the aforesaid position, a consented order is passed and the proceedings of the present case are ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh and are ordered to be transferred to the Courts at Mohali.

The entire record be sent immediately to the Courts at Mohali and learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali shall either himself try the matter or assign the matter to some Magistrate who shall proceed further, in accordance with law.

Office is directed to send complete record which had been requisitioned, back to the learned trial Court at Chandigarh which shall further transmit the same to the Court at Mohali.

In view of the above directions, the present petition stands disposed of.
