Petitioner-Kuldeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 13.03.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, under Sections 307, 506, 295, 427, 380, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR and no role is attributed to him. Learned State counsel has not pointed out any active role or participation by the present

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petitioner in the occurrence. According to learned State counsel, no injury is attributed to the present petitioner.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 13.03.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
