The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 19th February, 2016, registered under Sections 459, 458, 427, 323, 325, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

2. The petitioner was originally on bail but absented from the proceedings on certain dates as in the meantime he was taken into custody in some other case.

3. Subsequently, he was declared a Proclaimed Offender following issuance of coercive processes against him.

4. Petitioner's submission in this regard is that having remained in detention he was not aware of the warrants issued against him.

5. Considering the aforesaid background and the fact that following his re-arrest the petitioner has remained in a further period of detention in excess of two months by now, at this stage he may be released on bail on appropriate terms & conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
