This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 307, 326-B, 427, 436, 201, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 3, 4 Explosive Substances Act, 1908 (Sections 3, 4 of Prevention of Damage of Public Property Act, 1984 was added later on), at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide FIR No.119 dated 25.08.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner threw acid on owner of the petrol pump leading to burn injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
