The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.371 dated 28.10.2003 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 308, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Banga (now Police Station Mukandpur), District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Heard.

FIR was registered on the statement of Amarjit with regard to inflicting the injuries by the petitioner. However, now compromise has been effected between the parties and a separate petition bearing CRM-M-22946-2018 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is pending before this court.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 29.5.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
