Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Anil Kumar, PS Old Sabji Mandi, Rohtak submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute. However, the complainant side has sought to oppose the same on the grounds that the part of the gold ornaments is yet to be recovered.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.7.2017 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
