The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.115 dated 12th April, 2018, registered under Sections 406/420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar.

2. The petitioner who is a woman was arrested on 21st April, 2018.

3. Admittedly, there is civil litigation between the parties

and the last offence imputed to the petitioner in the FIR following the earlier compromise arrived at between the parties can at best come within the purview of “trespass” related offences, which are primarily bailable in nature.

4. Considering the detention undergone by the present petitioner till now at this stage, she may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
