The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint IPC No.06 dated 11.03.2015 titled as “Sandeep Singh versus Darshan Singh”, under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 120-B IPC, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur and summoning order dated 16.07.2015 and other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
