The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 822, dated 10.11.2017, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are civil in nature and the petitioner is ready to render all possible cooperation to the police.

It is manifest from perusal of the FIR that the petitioner had taken money from the husband of the complainant for investment in Malvanwal and Pargati Nidhi Company and the money was not returned.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Dayanand states that the petitioner had floated as many as three companies and is alleged to have duped innocent investors into parting with their hard earned money. 16 complainants had come

forward to depose against the petitioner in the instant FIR.

Therefore, as the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature as he has duped innocent investors of their hard earned money, his custodial interrogation would be necessary to unearth the scam.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
