ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 181 dated 11.04.2017, registered under Sections 323, 363, 366-A, 376 IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the prosecutrix is major and has not supported the prosecution version. Counsel for the petitioner says that bail has been allowed to co-accused Ravi and Kuldeep.

State counsel says that there were two victims and bailable warrants have been issued against the sister of Salma as well as the complainant.

The witnesses are avoiding the witness box. The trial would take time. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is

allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate.
