AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had moved an application for exemption from personal appearance before the trial Court, which was not accepted and because of his non-appearance, non-bailable warrants have been issued against him. He states that all through the petitioner had been appearing before the trial Court and would continue to do so but because of issuance of non-bailable warrants, the petitioner could not appear before the Court. He further states that the next date of hearing before the trial Court on 30.05.2018, on which date he would appear and surrender to the jurisdiction of the Court, apart from moving an application for grant of bail. He has also taken this Court through the order dated 17.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class to assert that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court and has not absented himself during trial.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with an observation that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court on 30.05.2018 and on surrender moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be entertained and he be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the said Court.
