Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the FIR No.129 dated 10.11.2016 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, along with all consequential proceedings therefrom on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties.

Vide order dated 20.07.2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 13.09.2017 to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise. Thereafter, vide order dated 27.02.2018, on an application moved by the petitioners to seek another opportunity to get their statements recorded in terms of the order dated 20.07.2017, this Court has again directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 08.03.2018, to get their statements recorded.

However, vide communication dated 24.05.2018, learned Addl.

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala, has reported that despite there being an order dated 27.02.2018 to appear before the trial court to get their statements recorded, parties have not come forward. Despite another opportunity having been granted to the parties, no appearance of the parties before the trial Court shows either there is no compromise or the parties have lost interest in the present petition.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, this Court is left with no other option except to dismiss the present petition for non-prosecution.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

However, in case there is a fresh compromise between the parties, the petitioners are at liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR in question.
