JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 33 dated 4.3.2018, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this is a case where the sister of the complainant and the petitioner ran away to get married. However, at that time respondent No.3 was minor. Now with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been settled and the families of both the parties have agreed to solemnize of the marriage of the petitioner and respondent No.3, who has attained majority now.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not oppose the grant

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of bail and admits the factum of the settlement and he also prays that the petitioner be released on bail so as to enable to him and his sister to solemnize marriage.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
