Petitioner-Manga @ Mangal Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 19 dated 2.3.2018 under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No. 4, District Patiala.

Heard.

It comes out that petitioner was arrested on 3.3.2018 for snatching the purse of a woman containing gold jewelry and cash etc.

Learned State counsel submits that in this case challan has been presented and most of witnesses(s) have been examined.

It being so, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to following conditions: -

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
