RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing Criminal Complaint No. 495 dated 08.11.2012 instituted on 01.12.2012 titled as ***Dev Raj and another Versus Krishan Lal and others*** registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B & 506 pending in the Court of Sh. Lokesh Gupta, ACJM, Nuh (Annexure P-1) and summoning order dated 30.01.2013 (Annexure P-2) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 28.05.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court, to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, the parties appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mewat and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 02.07.2018. Report from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mewat, vide letter No. 1187 dated 05.07.2018, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Mewat, has been received. According to the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mewat, the compromise is genuine and the parties have entered into the same voluntarily, without any undue influence, pressure and coercion from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid Criminal Complaint No. 495 dated 08.11.2012 instituted on 01.12.2012 titled as Dev Raj and another Versus Krishan Lal and summoning order dated 30.01.2013 (Anneuxre P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
