The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.117 dated 14.04.2015 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance of order dated 23.01.2018, the petitioners No. 1, 13, 17 have joined investigation on 28.03.2018; petitioner No.14 has joined on 24.03.2018; petitioners No. 2 to 12, 15, 16 have joined on 15.03.2018 and petitioner No. 18 has joined on 07.03.2018 and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

On instructions from SI Jaikaran, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that

the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
