In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.347 dated 15.06.2018 under Sections 379, 411 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner had the benefit of bail. For violating the bail order, court below cancelled his bail and proceeded to declare the petitioner as proclaimed offender on 11.10.2012. From that date till today petitioner has not approached court below. Therefore, one has to examine the conduct of the petitioner. Having regard to the conduct of the petitioner with reference to above factual aspect he is not entitled for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.

He is directed to surrender before the trial court. Thereafter, if he makes application for grant of bail, trial court is permitted to consider the same within a reasonable period of 1 week.
