Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the fact that a co-accused of the petitioner, Amanvir Singh, from whom a .32 bore revolver is stated to have been recovered, has already been admitted to bail by this Court on 12.01.2018, upon CRM-M-49772-2017 having been filed by the aforesaid person.

As already recorded in that order, though shots are stated to have been fired at the police party, which hit the door and bumper of the car in which they were travelling, no projectiles was recovered; and today, upon query from learned State counsel, he on instructions submits that there are no photographs also of the car having been hit with any revolver shots.

Consequently, without making any further comment on the issue, with the evidence to be gone into by the trial Court, the petitioner already having been in custody for about four months, with the trial still at a nascent stage, this petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
